Coaches/Officials Room: Our staff room will be available for coaches and officials, please make yourself at home. Drinks and snacks will be available both days.

- e) Please supervise your players throughout the school. **No basketballs allowed to be used in hallways or common area.**


Provincial Basketball Championships: March 14 – 16, Immanuel Chrisitan School, Lethbridge.

Tournament Format:

8 team draw: **PLEASE SEND A COPY OF YOUR ROSTER SO WE CAN BE PREPARED WITH GAME SHEETS.**

Teams will be given a minimum 15-minute minimum warm-up and a 10-minute half time. Our gymnasium change rooms will be available for teams playing until the end of halftime at which point the following game teams will be allowed to enter them.

We have scheduled the games with a 1:45 time slot; please be prepared to take the court so we can stay on schedule.



Tournament Notes:

1. Home team will be on the top of the draw, will occupy the home bench (change room end) and wear DARK COLOURED jerseys.
2. The gym floor will be for players and coaches only; please ensure they have dry shoes or removed their shoes for entering the gym.
3. Spectators will enter the stage from the stage door, not the gymnasium doors; this will be labelled.
4. Change rooms are available before the game and at half time; after half time the change room will be transferred to the next games teams. These change rooms will not be locked, so please do not leave valuables inside.
5. The home team will occupy the boys change room – bench side, and the away team will occupy the girls change room – score clock side.
6. Our table will be run by junior high players, please be patient and kind to them.
7. There is a small concession for the weekend and restaurants in town are expecting your calls for reservations – Gondola's is recommended. Fort Saskatchewan is also only a 25-minute drive away if you wish to spend more time away from the school.
8. The coach's room will be in our staff room – please make yourself at home.
9. Travel safe – If you need anything or are running late the PE office number is 780-895-2228, Ext 3761, or leave a message with the office.
10. The main doors to the school will be the only ones open, they are on the east side along the highway by the school sign. There is no parking on the highway but lots on the northside of the school for busses and lots on the south side of the school for passenger vehicles. Our school busses will be in the south lot until 3:30 Friday afternoon.
